Reflecting on the changing Colors of the Seasons leads me to remind our SBS Library users of some colors at play in the Library. I am referring to the Four Colors used to distinguish a book's appropriate reading audience: YELLOW, WHITE, BLUE and RED. YELLOW label books are for primary grades TK to 2nd. A fiction book with a WHITE label & an E is geared to Grades 2/3 to 5/6; and WHITE label books with FIC designation are advised for 5/6 grades and above. BLUE label books are available for the middle school & more mature readers. And the RED label is for Reference books, usually not borrowed but available to all to read in the Library.
